

Palmyra Dragway Presidents Report October 2017.

The last period has seen lots of work completed at our facility.

- 1) Concrete and tyre barriers completed on burnout pad.
- 2) Concrete repairs to braking area.
 - a. Armco to be re installed and area cleaned up.
 - b. 1/4 mile beams to be reinstalled and tested.
 - c. Race your Mates on 28th of October and Keep Speed of the street on Nov 17th will see all bikes as well as cars slower than 10 seconds run over the ¼ mile distance.
 - d. The two events above will allow the committee to complete an assessment on the rest of the braking area and set time cut offs for ¼ mile racing for the 2018 season.
- 3) The contractor has started on new perimeter fencing
- 4) Planning is well under way for opening of the burn out pad on the 28th on October. Information on this event is continually being updated on our web site and FB Page.
- 5) The full council had a meeting at the track. This gave your committee members the opportunity to discuss directly with them the benefits of our facility to the local community and business that also benefit when our facility is running to its full potential. We also discussed the drainage issues at our facility and requested better signage on the Peak Downs Highway.
- 6) Work has also commenced to better delineate pit areas and internal roadways through the pit area.
- 7) Concrete works between the two storage containers has been completed.

The Management committee have been working on a new fee structure for race meetings and club memberships. Our proposal is attached to this report and will be a discussion point at our club meeting on November the 6th. Venue yet to be confirmed.

The Club AGM will be the 9th of December nominations for positions on the management committee need to be submitted by the 9th of November.

Proposed 2018 Palmyra Drag Club Member Fees.

- 1) Club membership \$120.00 yearly and includes:
 - a. Photo ID Membership card for the current year
 - b. Free entry into venue at PDRC run events when membership card is displayed.
- 2) Life Members **voluntary** \$60.00 yearly to receive:
 - a. Photo ID Membership card for the current year
 - b. Free entry into venue at PDRC run events when membership card is displayed.
 - c. **Life members don't have to purchase card to remain a member.**
- 3) Honorary Life members **pay a one off** \$60 to receive:
 - a. Photo ID Life Membership card
 - b. Free entry into venue at PDRC run events when membership card is displayed.
 - c. **Honorary Life members don't have to purchase a card to remain members.**
- 4) Gold Card holders **pay a one off** \$60 to receive:
 - a. Photo ID Gold Membership card
 - b. Free entry into venue at PDRC run events when membership card is displayed.
 - c. **The original Gold card will still be valid for entry to venue when accompanied with photo ID.**
- 5) Replacement cards will be charged at \$50 each.

Racer entries Fees for 2018 Year.

- 1) All racers will pay the same entry fee no discount for members or Gold Card members.
- 2) Club Championship Events will be set at \$110.00 for each competitor. \$130.00 for Race meeting and Friday night Test and Tune
- 3) Junior Dragster Club Championship Events will be set at \$50.00 per competitor.
- 4) Entry fees for special events will be set by the committee.
- 5) Divisional Day Licences \$10.00 per event.
- 6) Friday Night Keep Speed of the Street meetings \$50.00 per entrant.
- 7) Crew arm bands will be exchanged for gate entry ticket at Admin building.

This concept means

- 1) That every member of the club gets a benefit in being a member and may encourage more members and a more diverse range of members.
- 2) People that use the track to race pay for the privilege.

Current paid life members and Gold Card holder's club memberships will expire on the 1st of January 2020. All efforts put in by all club members in the past is appreciated but in a day and age were very few people are able to give up time for free to keep the facility maintained more and more services need to be paid for so all club members need to pay for the privilege to be a club member. **This will not affect honorary life members.**

This is recommended by the Management Committee and will be put to a club members for discussion and acceptance at the November 7th Club meeting.
