



## KEEP THE SPEED OFF THE STREETS @ PALMYRA DRAGWAY

What you need to know if you've never raced:

### At the racers Administration Office

Open from 4.30pm – 7.00pm

You will find the entry form to fill in outside the office door, please complete both front and back (if req.)

Costs: \$50.00

If you do not hold an IHRA License you will also have to purchase an IHRA DL (Day License) for \$15.00 this will enable you to run.

- 12 seconds or slower
- 10 seconds or slower if vehicle is originally (factory) fitted with airbags and 4-wheel disc brakes
- 9.5 seconds or slower for factory built motorcycles.

You will also need your Drivers licenses (provisional at a minimum)

Once you have completed the necessary paperwork and paid your nomination you will then be issued with an arm band and your race number for the event, this is to be shown to the scrutineering official. Armband must remain on your wrist for the entire event for confirmation of DL and acceptance of the event and all Palmyra Drag Racing Club & IHRA Rules. The scrutineering shed is where an inspection will be carried out to ensure that your car or bike is in a condition suitable for the race track

### At the Scrutineering Shed

Open from 4.30pm – 7.00pm

You Must present to the scrutineering shed with your car/bike in race ready condition and...

- Wrist Band on wrist and DL Number
- Approved Helmet (info available online at [www.ihra.com.au](http://www.ihra.com.au))
- Long Pants
- Long sleeved shirt
- Enclosed shoes and socks
- Leather Boots above ankle for motorcycle
- IHRA license holders with log books must present at the scrutineering shed with completed CAD form, log book, helmet and wrist band to get signed off.
- NO oil or water leaks to be evident, all batteries to be secure and air conditioning is to remain OFF
- All loose items are to be removed from vehicle prior to inspection
- A working tail light that is visible from a distance is required for race eligibility.

**Scrutineering officials reserve the right to fail any vehicle that does not pass any of the required safety checks as set out by IHRA or those deemed necessary by Palmyra Drag Racing Club.**
