

Palmyra Dragway Keep Speed off the Streets Safety Information

Note: From 01/08/2010 all motorcycle riders and car drivers will be required to use full-face helmets. Open-face helmets will not be acceptable after this date for any motorcycle rider or car driver.

Drivers

Drivers of vehicles slower than 10.99-seconds (1/4 mile) are permitted to use any helmet (full-face or open-face) meeting one of the following Standards:

- SNELL SA2000, SA2005, SFI 31.2A (USA)
- SNELL M2000, M2005, SFI 41.2A (USA)
- BS 6658-1985
- AS/NZS 1698:2006 or AS/NZS 1698.

Personal protective equipment consisting of long trousers, long sleeve shirt or jacket, enclosed footwear and one of the above helmets.

Riders

Riders of motorcycles slower than 10.00-seconds (1/4 mile) must use a full-face helmet meeting one of the following Standards:

- SNELL SA2000, SA2005, SFI 31.2A (USA)
- SNELL M2000, M2005, SFI 41.2A (USA)
- BS 6658-1985
- AS/NZS 1698:2006 or AS/NZS 1698.

Personal protective equipment consisting of long trousers, long sleeve shirt or jacket, enclosed footwear and one of the above helmets.

Riders please note:

Only riders of motorcycles slower than 10.99-seconds (1/4 mile) are permitted to use any helmet (full-face or open-face) meeting one of the following Standards:

- SNELL SA2000, SA2005, SFI 31.2A (USA)
- SNELL M2000, M2005, SFI 41.2A (USA)
- BS 6658-1985
- AS/NZS 1698:2006 or AS/NZS 1698.

Personal protective equipment consisting of long trousers, long sleeve shirt or jacket, enclosed footwear and one of the above helmets.
